

BOOKING TERMS

1. RISK STATEMENT

SEAS is a volunteer led Charity with activities being delivered in conjunction with, and risk managed by, the Conway Centre; Anglesey.

It must be recognised that adventurous activities by their nature contain an element of unpredictability and therefore inherently involve an element of risk. By taking part in SEAS activities, you agree and acknowledge that:

- (i) You are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in adventurous activities and you accept responsibility for exposing yourself to such inherent risk whilst taking part in SEAS sessions;
- (ii) You will comply at all times with the instructions of the Conway Centre appointed SEAS duty person/volunteer activity leader particularly with regard to instructions for operating at height or boarding and leaving the boat and/or launching and recovery (as relevant), using specialist outdoor equipment, wearing of buoyancy aids/climbing harnesses, lifejackets and the wearing of suitable clothing in particular footwear for the conditions
- (iii) You accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own negligence;
- (iv) You will not participate in SEAS sessions if your ability to participate is impaired by alcohol, drugs or if you are otherwise unfit to participate;
- (v) You will inform the SEAS duty person if there have been any changes to the information provided on this form at the time of the session.
- (vi) The provision of supervision by the Conway Centre appointed SEAS duty person is limited to such assistance, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- (vii) You understand that the SEAS sessions are intended to give participants a chance to experience adventurous activities. You will be offered the chance to take part in the activities under the guidance of a representative of SEAS who has been assessed by the Conway Centre as competent and sufficiently experienced to supervise your experience. These representatives may not be qualified instructors. The SEAS sessions are not intended to provide specific tuition or instruction.
- (viii) You are aware of any specific risks drawn to your attention by the Conway Centre appointed SEAS duty person/s.

The SEAS Sailability Charity very much hopes that you will enjoy the sessions and will be able to advise you on how to obtain tuition and instruction should you wish to take your experience to the next stage.

2. CANCELLATION

You understand that the Conway Centre may cancel or postpone the SEAS sessions at any stage in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise.

3. MISCONDUCT

You understand that the Conway Centre appointed SEAS duty person may exclude anyone from a particular session and evict anyone from the premises who refuses to comply with these Booking Terms or who misconducts themselves in any way or who causes damage or annoyance to other persons.

4. DATA PROTECTION

The SEAS Sailability Charity and the Conway Centre have Data Privacy Policies which can be obtained by application.

Your data will be used and stored in accordance with that policy.

The information you provide to SEAS will be used to facilitate your participation in the SEAS sessions and to contact you.
